



International Vintage Master : specialising in the international wine sector.

The International Vintage Master (Vine, Wine and Terroir Management), a 4 semester course, aims to train international wine industry executives in the technological, marketing and economical sides. It is led by Groupe ESA (University of Agriculture and Food Sciences), France, in partnership with 8 of the best European universities and 3 non European ones. The course is currently selected as Erasmus Mundus Master course by the European Commission as **one of the 103 “Masters of excellence” in Europe.**

A total of 83 students from 35 nationalities have been graduated with the International Vintage Master's degree since the beginning in September 2002. Now, 47 % work in trade and marketing, 23% as executives in the technical field, 9 % in consulting, 7 % in teaching and research. 7 % are working in wine institutions

Thanks to the Erasmus Mundus label, the International Vintage Master Course offers to **European students a 3 month scholarship of 3100 euros/per person/per academic year**, for studying or making an internship period in Chile (Pontifica Universidade de Chile), or in South Africa (University of Stellenbosch). There are other possibilities of scholarships (please ask us).

The International Vintage Master course is open to students and professionals from all countries. Applicants must hold a good Bachelor of Science's degree (including Economics), and show deep interest into the wine sector. They must in have a good level in English and in French.
